# **Online Safety Focus**

The school welcomed Andrew Gunn, a leading Computing Consultant for ESCC, on Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> February. He led workshops with parents and children in each Key Stage, highlighting the benefits to online use and how to stay safe.

In January, the Local Authority hosted a Safeguarding Conference which included key speakers on the importance of online safety. One particular resource is now on our school website (News, February 2020) and features Goldilocks who realises the hidden dangers of posting photographs online which may be useful for you to share at home.

In the afternoon Catherine McAllister, Head of Editorial Standards and Safeguarding at Children's BBC presented on the recently launched **BBC Own it App**. This innovative app is downloaded on to a child's phone and will actively monitor the content of their social media interactions. This is not an app which allows parents to spy on their children, instead it will prompt children to reconsider the use of harmful language in messages or provide signposting to support if a child indicates they are distressed. Within the presentation Catherine spoke about the following three concepts:

- Digital Natives
- Digital Footprint
- Independent Digital Citizens

Children do not know a world without the internet and smart phones (unlike us old folk) so in that respect they are digital natives. This may give the impression that they know what they're doing with technology but demonstrably they do not! Digital footprint speaks for itself. The app is aimed at supporting children to become independent digital citizens.

At the moment the app only picks up on harmful language, such as children saying they hate someone or that wish they were dead etc. In time the BBC want to develop the app to identify the 'language of resistance' to identify when children may be being coerced or pressured into things, so that the app can then signpost towards speaking with an adult or seeking support elsewhere.

#### Visit to Kent Life

Year 3 had a great time during their trip to Kent Life on Thursday, 6th February. We took part in a Viking workshop, had a train ride round the park, had fun playing in the playground and saw some pigs!



# Visit to Brooklands Motor Museum
