How does PE link with our school values at Western Road?

Well-Rounded – our PE lessons follow the GetSet4PE scheme of work alongside team and individual sports. We provide inclusive lessons to ensure ALL children enjoy their PE learning and can demonstrate new skills. Our sports teams are inclusive and actively promote positive discrimination.

Resilient – we provide opportunities for after-school clubs and intra-school events to provide a healthy sense of competition and show that it is okay to win OR lose!

Pupil Voice - our PE subject leader regularly completes Pupil Voice activities with the children to see if there is anything we can improve with our clubs, equipment, or PE lessons.
